

Aerials gymnasts soar

Mizuki McCall and Tatum Bales finished 1-2 in Level 7 competition at their home gym during Aerials Gymnastics' Sweetheart Invitational on Feb. 19.

McCall won the vault and floor disciplines, while Bales won the balance beam and was second in the vault. Meryl Glass finished with a strong all-around score of 32.000.

Aerials' Kate Campbell finished second all-around in Level 6 after winning on the balance beam, taking second on the vault and floor, and placing third on the uneven bars.

Kailyn Murphy won the bars and beam en route to a first-place all-around finish in the Level 5 Older Division. Carolyn Fine was second in the floor and beam exercises and third on the bars as she finished third. Samantha Hulbert was first on the vault and second on the bars, while Emily Ichikawa took third on the vault and floor. Kristina Coleman finished with a 31.350 all-around score.

Tia Clay placed third on the bars in the Level 5 Younger Division. Jessica Fitch and Megan Bull tied for second on the vault and Bull was third on the beam.

Logan McConie, Victoria Laren and Alison Fortin placed 1-3, respectively, in the Level 4 Division. McConie took first on the floor, beam and bars, and second on the vault. Laren was second on the floor, beam and bars, and third on the vault. Fortin placed first on the vault and third on the beam and floor.

Isabella Martinez took first place on the vault and floor as she took third all-around in the Level 4 Middle Division. Tessa Bales was second on the vault and third on the beam. Ashley Durant finished third on the bars and floor, while Savannah Staley was third on the vault.

Sophia Shimboff placed second all-around in the Level 4 Younger Division after taking first on the vault and second on the bars and floor.
